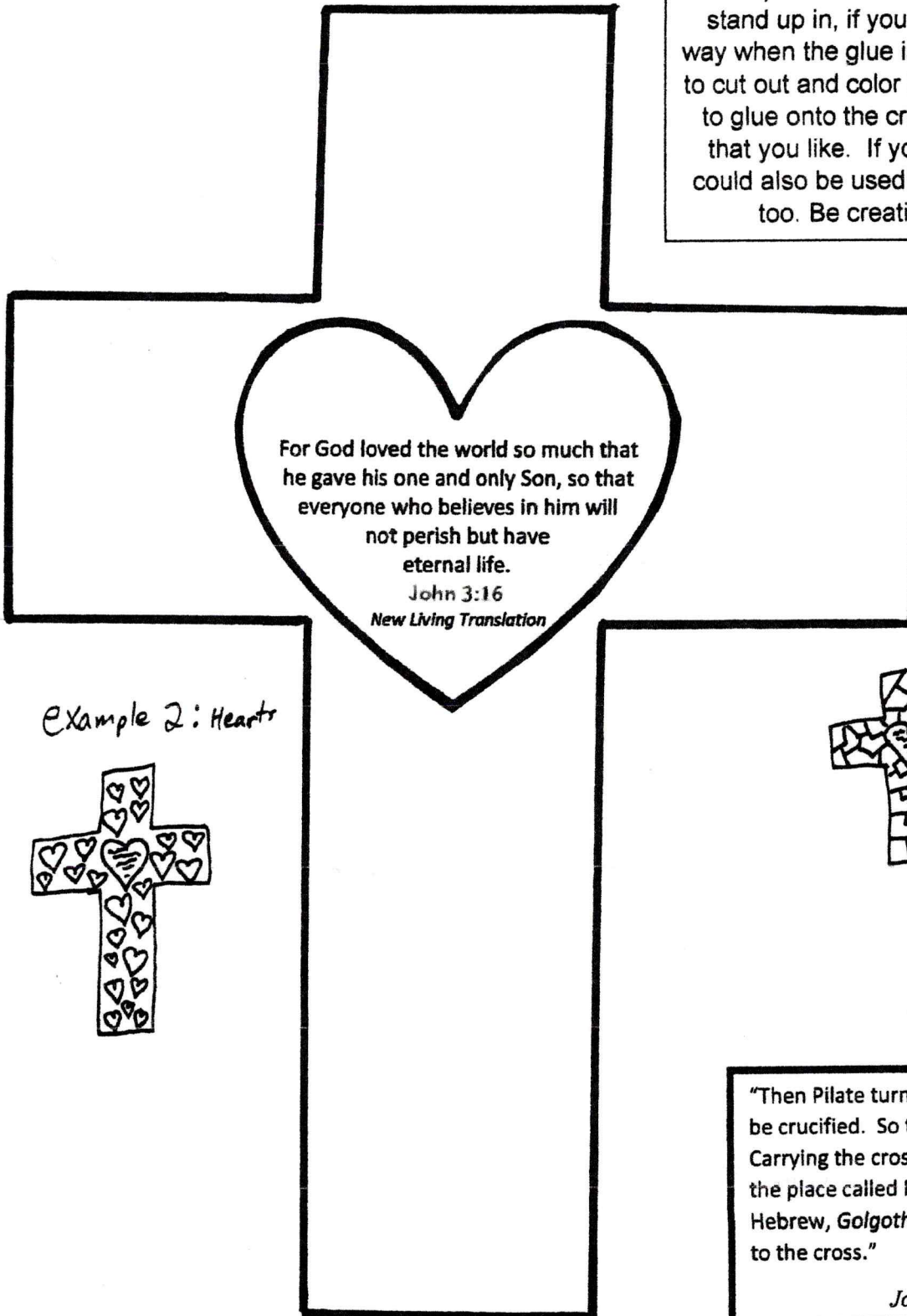


Foam Cross with John 3:16

For March 31st

Below is a copy of the foam cross for this activity. Use this to make the cross look like stained glass- color the pieces, cut them out, and then glue them to the cross using the Elmer's Glue-All (this type of glue works better than regular glue for use on foam). There is a base for this cross to stand up in, if you want to display it this way when the glue is dry. Another option is to cut out and color hearts of different sizes to glue onto the cross, or another shape that you like. If you have stickers, they could also be used to decorate this cross, too. Be creative and have fun!
