Resurrection Eggs

The items in the resurrection eggs have special significance in the life, death and resurrection of Our Lord, Jesus Christ. The eggs hold a great treasure.

The donkey – represents the colt that Jesus rode into Jerusalem. The crowds shouted, “Hosanna, Hosanna, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.” (Matthew 21:9)

The coins – One of the twelve, whose name was Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, “What will you give me if I deliver Him over to you?” And they paid him thirty pieces of silver. (Matthew 26:14-15)

The cup – He gave it to them, saying, “Drink of it, all of you, for this is My blood...which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.” (Matthew 26:27-28)

Praying Hands – And they went to a place called Gethsemane. And He said to His disciples, “sit here while I pray.” (Matthew 26:36)

The Leather Whip – But after having Jesus scourged, he [Pilate] handed Him over to be crucified. (Matthew 27:26)

Crown of Thorns – And after twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on His head ... and they knelt down before Him and mocked Him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!” (Matthew 27:29)

Nails in the Cross – So they took Jesus...bearing His own cross, to the place...called Golgotha. There they crucified Him... (John 19:17-18)

Die – And when they had crucified Him, they divided up His garments among themselves by casting lots. (Matthew 27:35)

Spear – But coming to Jesus, when they saw that He was already dead...one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. (John 19:33-34)

Linen Cloth – There came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph... He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. And Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen shroud. (Matthew 27:57-59)

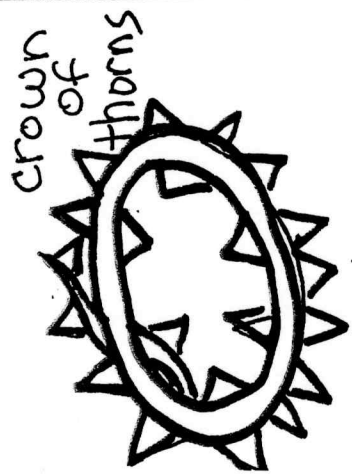
Stone – and laid it in his own new tomb...and he rolled a large stone against the entrance of the tomb. (Matthew 27:60)

Empty Egg – An angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it. The angel said to the women, “He is not here, for He has risen just as he said...” (Matthew 28:2,5)

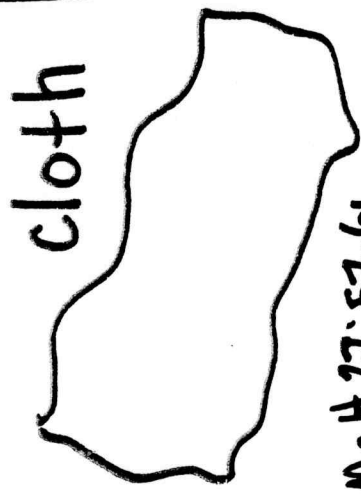

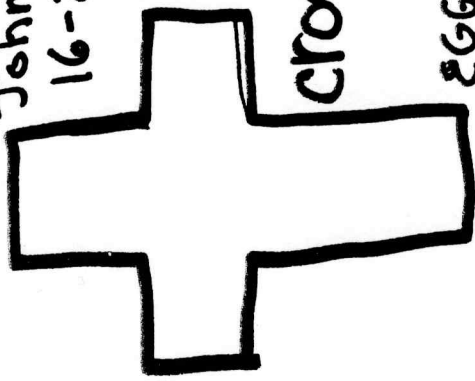

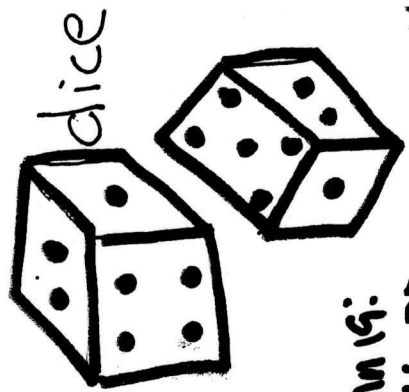

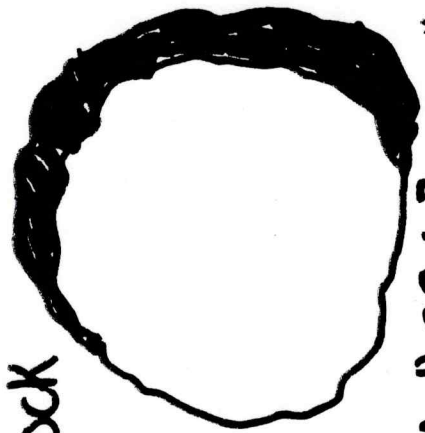
