



March Mission Giving Opportunities

- 1. Dahlgren Christian Preschool (DCP): This DUMC ministry offers, in a Christian environment and through Christian teaching, a foundation needed by preschool children for life in general and for their future education. They offer a wide range of creative, academic, and social activities that are age appropriate and provide a complete early childhood curriculum. Local public teachers can always tell when a student came from the DCP program !!!
- 2. <u>Eastern Shore: Agape Christian Children's Community Center:</u> Located in Horntown, VA, Agape is a quality outreach ministry that reaches out to local children in an area of high risk for abuse, neglect, and school drop-out on the Eastern Shore. It shares education and the love of Christ through its preschool program, before/after school care and several summer programs. DUMC Mission teams have traveled several times to Agape to do repairs and upgrades to this facility.
- 3. <u>Rising Hope Mission Church (Alexandria</u>) Rising Hope Mission Church is United Methodist Church in Alexandria. Located an area of with a large population homeless and extreme poverty along the Rt 1 corridor. In addition to worship opportunities and spiritual support

available to the needy, the organization offers a Food Pantry, Soup kitchen, a Hope Closet for free clothing, and a Hypothermia Shelter during winter.

Help Make the KG Summer Lunch Bunch a Success !!!!!


The Summer Lunch Bunch is a cooperative of local churches that has mobilized each summer for the last eleven years to deliver free lunches to children in rural King George County, VA. The program is administered by a Board of Directors comprised of members from Dahlgren United Methodist Church, Peace Lutheran Church, St John's Episcopal Church, Trinity United Methodist Church and Two River Baptist Church. During the school year, approximately one third of King George elementary aged children receive free or reduced cost meals. When schools close for the summer. those meals also end.

The goals of the Church Cooperative are to:

- 1. Fill the nutritional gap for those students that exists during the summer vacation
- 2. Enable children to return to school in August in a better position to resume learning.



During the summer, the Lunch Bunch program operates Tuesdays and Thursday between June and July. Volunteers prepare bagged lunches which consist of a sandwich, a drink and other nonperishable items and a free book that the kids can keep. Other volunteers drive these lunches to various locations and deliver meals to the students directly from their vehicles. Flyers are distributed to notify all King George public school students of locations and time of delivery. No registration is necessary. Over a 14 week period in 2023, the Lunch Bunch Program prepared and delivered 1,500 lunches. There were 67 people who volunteered in some capacity to support the program. Lunch Bunch is beginning to spin up for the 2024 Summer Break. The program is currently in need of volunteer support to help





costs, financial donations are also needed to secure the amounts of required food stocks. Generous donations of your God given gifts of time and treasure will be greatly appreciated.

Saturday night, March 30th, will be a lock-in starting at 7:00 pm. It will be followed by the Easter Sunrise Service at 6:30 am on Easter Sunday (March 31st). This service is entirely run by the youth. The SYG is open to youth and young adults from 8th grade through college. We welcome new participants.


