hung on the mantel with care


It is indeed the birth of that little baby boy

#### Worship



**Worship** can be defined as "the reverence or adoration that one shows toward something or someone; holding a person or object in high esteem; or giving a person or an object, a place of importance or honor."

It is a Biblical mandate that we **Worship God** and **Him** alone. It is an act that is designed to not only bring honor to **Him**, who deserves honor, but also to bring a spirit of obedience and submission to the worshippers.

The role of **Worship** in the Church is to glorify **God** and to give **Him** thanks for **His** blessings. **Worship** is a time when Christians gather together in fellowship to sing, to pray, to offer sacrifices and to be taught the "Word of **God**". It is a time to be encouraged in faith and to grow spiritually. It can occur in small groups such as Sunday schools, Prayer groups and Bible study groups. #### What does a Church Worship Team do?

A Church Worship Team's overall responsibility is to build and maintain a growing and healthy spiritual life in the overall Church and it's Sunday Worship experience. A Spiritual Culture that meets and supports the worship goals of the Church Congregation and the surrounding Community.

To better provide spiritual value-added and benefit, a Church Worship Team must be aware of the worship needs and desires of a Congregation. The Team must be sensitive to new worship styles and to congregational traditions. By asking appropriate questions of the Congregation and working with the Pastor, the Church Worship Team must strive to always provide a vibrant Church Worship Experience that will help people of all ages to grow in their spiritual journey to better understanding God, His Love and His Gospel. The Worship Team Goal is for Congregation members to leave a Church Worship Experience feeling Spiritually Up Lifted and Better Equipped for Daily Living as Faithful Disciples.

In addition, a Church Worship Team will also work in areas for:

- Promoting individual, small group and family worship opportunities for spiritual formation outside of Church Services
- Training and supporting worship leaders such as acolytes, scripture readers, ushers, greeters, artists and others to include the required sanctuary protocols and sanctuary etiquette.
- Working with other Church ministry leaders so that worship is celebrated in the whole life and culture of the Congregation and the Community

A Congregation is never static. As it changes and evolves, so does its worship needs and desires. A Pastor and the Church Worship Team must take the responsibility for periodically assessing those needs and suggesting appropriate revisions of liturgy and sanctuary if required. The actions of a Pastor and a Congregation, working together, are most critical in creating dynamic worship in today's world. After all, the word Liturgy means, quite simply...... the "work of the people".






#### **GENERAL FUND**
